Frequently asked questions

What time should I arrive?

You should arrive 10 minutes before your session is due to start.

Where should I go to when I arrive to school?

You must arrive to the main reception. A member of staff will be on reception to let you in the building.

What do I do when I arrive?

You must sign in on the sheets provided at reception. You will then wait for your teacher to come and collect you.

What if I arrive late?

Avoid lateness as this will mean you will miss part of your session. You will also need to wait in reception for a member of staff to escort you to the session.

Where will the sessions be taking place?

The sessions will mostly be in the FLZ unless a specific room such as a computer or art room is needed. The rooms are shown on the timetable.

What do I do when the session is finished?

Your teacher will escort you back to main reception where you will need to sign out on the sheets provided.

If you have another session you will need to wait in reception for the teacher of your next session to come and collect you. You must still sign in on the sheet provided for your next session.

What if I need to leave early?

A member of staff will escort you to the main reception where you will sign out and leave the building.
